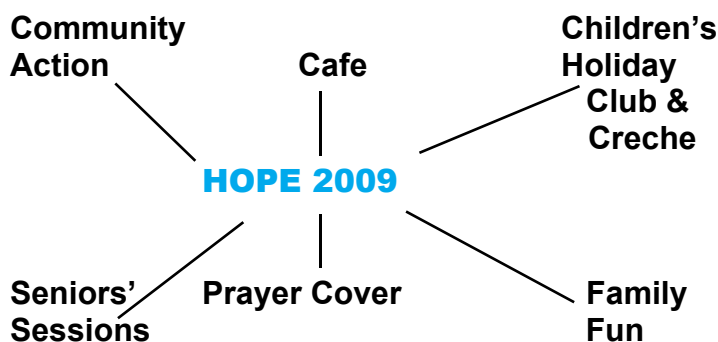


Thursday 27th August - Sunday 30th August
